Stories about the show's characters revolve around universal themes of wonder, courage, play, compassion, friendship and respect - particularly for nature.

Each episode features a fun segment where Little Bigfoot's imagination delves into the stories and characters of classic literature.

Mother Nature narrates the show with her soothing voice. She pleasantly describes each story like a parent reading to a child.

SUMMARY

Little Bigfoot is a playful eight-year-old sasquatch with an active imagination and a spirited ambition to be a legendary explorer. His motto is to "*Be legendary!*"

Little Bigfoot lives in the Neighborwoods, a large forest filled with creatures big and small. His two best friends are a hyper-active chipmunk named Twig and a curious human named Jada. They go on exciting adventures through the Neighborwoods, where they discover nature and learn about the world around them.

Little Bigfoot also enjoys time spent with his family. Especially his grandfather, who tells Little Bigfoot fantastic stories about the legendary characters found in his collection of books left behind by humans.

Mother Nature narrates the show. She engages the audience with a friendly greeting, her happy face appearing in something like a flower bush, tree trunk or waterfall. She sets up the story for each episode and offers our young audience a deeper understanding of what is unfolding on screen. Her relaxed energy sets a playful and positive tone that children and parents will love.



MAIN CHARACTERS



LITTLE BIGFOOT

Playful child sasquatch who likes to have fun exploring the Neighborwoods, learning about nature, and making friends to go on legendary adventures with.

MOTHER NATURE

Friendly narrator who identifies important story details, such as what emotions the characters are feeling, and what discoveries Little Bigfoot makes while exploring the great outdoors.



SECONDARY CHARACTERS



TWIG

Spunky female chipmunk, and Little Bigfoot's best friend, who shares an insatiable appetite for adventure, but often bites off more than she can chew.



JADA

Clever human camper who discovers Little Bigfoot and finds they share much in common, like their strong imaginations and penchant for exploration.



RINGO

Shy and sensitive male raccoon who really admires Little Bigfoot for his courage and kindness to strangers.



FLICK

Jokey male woodpecker who likes to entertain Little Bigfoot, but can sometimes be a bit of a distraction.



BARK, BITE, AND GROWL

Mean wolf siblings, two boys and a girl, who like to cause trouble for Little Bigfoot and his friends.



WYLIE AND RYLIE

Fun-loving twin bears, male and female, who enjoy playing games with Little Bigfoot but often need a lesson in how to play fair.



BIG MOMMA

Little Bigfoot's mother, a caring nurturer who encourages her family to be kind to the world around them.



BIG POPPA

Little Bigfoot's father, an adventurous provider who inspires Little Bigfoot's desire to explore.

THE BIGFOOT FAMILY



BABY FOOT

Little Bigfoot's little sister, an adorable toddler who Little Bigfoot can't wait to bring on adventures.



GRANDSQUATCH

Little Bigfoot's grandfather, a kooky elder who reads stories to Little Bigfoot and fuels his grandson's imagination.



THE NEIGHBORHOODS

This is where Little Bigfoot lives with his family and friends. A wilderness community of plant and animal life in the Pacific Northwest. The Neighborwoods consist of a variety of terrains that offer much for Little Bigfoot to explore, such as forests, caves, meadows, lakes, mountains, and waterfalls. It's a great place to have fun discovering the wonders of nature.

EPISODE I

FISHING TIME! (STORY 1A)

Little Bigfoot is going on his first fishing trip with Big Poppa. Poppa is an expert fisherman, and very excited to catch fish with Little Bigfoot. First, they try a pond, but it's too busy. Other animals are enjoying the water and scaring away the fish. Poppa suggests they try the river, but the current is strong and the fish are too fast to catch. Finally, they try a beautiful waterfall. However, they discover that there is no fish to be found under it. Poppa is upset that their fishing trip was a bust. However, Little Bigfoot surprisingly isn't upset at all. When they return home he enthusiastically tells the rest of their family about watching the mighty bears swim at the pond, chasing after salmon in the wild river, and deep-sea diving under the magnificent waterfall. Little Bigfoot reassures Poppa that their expedition wasn't a failure, they got to spend a legendary day together exploring the Neighborwoods.

BIG POPPA'S DRAGON (STORY 1B)

While out with Big Poppa and Grandsquatch, Little Bigfoot learns how to be a helpful trailblazer - opening paths in the forrests for the wildlife. A strange noise is heard in the distance. Little Bigfoot imagines that the noise came from a great beast. Poppa leaves to investigate, but doesn't allow Little Bigfoot to follow. Grandsquatch tells his grandson the story of *My Father's Dragon*. Little Bigfoot imagines himself as Elmer, a boy on a quest to find his father's missing dragon. He follows his father to Wild Island, a land of jungle beasts. There they must get past a counted total of 7 tigers, 2 boars, 1 rhinoceros and 17 crocodiles to reach the dragon. Poppa returns at the end of the story. He brings Little Bigfoot and Grandsquatch to the source of the noise, a fallen tree infested with bugs. Poppa shows his son how the bugs are helpful, as this tree will provide animals with homes. Grandsquatch remarks that the bugs are also tasty to eat!

JADA (STORY 1C)

In this story, Little Bigfoot is exploring the Neighborwoods in search of his favorite snack, blueberries. However, when he finds the blueberry bush he discovers that all of the berries are gone. He spots a trail of peculiar tracks near the bush. They look similar to his own feet but much smaller in size. He closely follows the tracks until he bumps into Jada, a real-life human! This is the first human he's ever met. He and Jada are amused by one another and become quick friends. They play together and Little Bigfoot learns that Jada too has a fun imagination. Unfortunately, their friendship comes to a momentary halt when Little Bigfoot uncovers that Jada is the one who took all the blueberries. She doesn't plan on sharing any of them with anyone. Little Bigfoot helps Jada realize that it's wrong to take more than what you need, especially in nature. Jada returns most of the berries to the Neighborwoods, and with the ones she keeps she introduces Little Bigfoot to his new favorite snack, blueberry pancakes.

Grandsquatch tells the story of *The Wonderful Wizard of Oz*. Little Bigfoot imagines Jada is Dorothy and that Grandsquatch is the Wizard that she's searching for.

THE FROG-SQUATCH

Grandsquatch tells the story of *The Frog Prince*. Little Bigfoot imagines himself as a frog in need of a transformational hug.

TROUBLE WITH GAMES

Little Bigfoot and his friends must find a way to compromise when they can't agree on which game to play.

THE SECRET CAVE

On a trip to his grandfather's secret cave, a place where great treasures are kept, Little Bigfoot accidentally gets separated from Grandsquatch and needs help finding him.

SASQUATCH SOUP

Big Momma and Little Bigfoot collect ingredients to make sasquatch soup, a home remedy to help Big Poppa feel well when he gets sick.
